PAXTON PRAISES US SUPREME COURT REFUSAL TO BLOCK ABORTION MEASURES

Conservative, pro-life candidate for Attorney General: "This is a good day"

(McKinney, TX) - Ken Paxton, conservative Republican candidate for Attorney General released the following statement concerning the U.S. Supreme Court's refusal to block Texas' historic pro-life legislation:

"I am thrilled the United States Supreme Court refused to intervene in a challenge to the constitutionality of the new Texas law that advances the culture of life. These common-sense regulations protect the lives of the mother and unborn, as well as require physicians to provide the highest standard of care to women. This is a good day.

As Attorney General, I will stand by Texas law when challenged in Court, but never with more fervor than in defense of those laws which advance the cause of life and liberty."

The United States Supreme Court is due to hear the case in full in 2014.
