## **Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association PAC Endorses Ken Paxton for Attorney General**

(McKinney, TX) - The Political Action Committee for the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association (TSCRA) have announced their endorsement of Ken Paxton, Republican nominee for Attorney General.
